## California Consumer Privacy Rights:

We do not sell your personal information so no opt-out choice is necessary. You have the right to request, twice in a 12-month period, the following information about the personal information we have collected about you during the past 12 months:

the categories and specific pieces of personal information we have collected about you;  
the categories of sources from which we collected the personal information;  
the business or commercial purpose for which we collected or sold the personal information;  
the categories of third parties with whom we shared the personal information; and  
the categories of personal information about you that we sold or disclosed for a business purpose, and the categories of third parties to whom we sold or disclosed that information for a business purpose.

You have the right to request that we delete the personal information we have collected from you. If you choose to exercise any of your rights under the CCPA, you have the right to not receive discriminatory treatment.
